#### GETTING THE GROUP TOGETHER

Who is the most spiritual person you know? Not superficially but in a genuinely loving, humble and righteous way? Someone who "walks with God."

This week you are being assigned a group project. Select an attribute of God and put together a group presentation. Assign different aspects of your project to each person and next week each person or couple needs to present to the rest of the group.

# THIS WEEK'S GROUP METHOD BIBLE STUDY

#### GATHER

Are y'all together? Great! Technically the P for Prayer isn't until the end of GROUP but go ahead and start with prayer as well!

#### READ

Have someone read Genesis chapters 1 - 2 out loud.

#### **OBSERVE**

During and after the reading, write down your thoughts and observations in your GROUP Method notebook or here. This is a very familiar passage but there are 2 things that we tend to skim over: The 1st is that God doesn't say that Adam is created in God's image, the Bible says that "man" or "mankind" was created in God's image. The 2nd thing to notice is that the only thing that "isn't good" is that Adam is alone. Everyhing else that God created was good.

## UNDERSTAND

Everyone go around and share your observations. Notice what stood out to y'all as a group, what everyone skimmed over, what common questions everyone had, or applications. Share anything that God might have put on your heart for someone else in the group. What does it mean for "mankind" to be in the image of God vs just man? Does that mean we are most in the image of God corporately?
