

# What if you could make all the time you need?

#### GETTING THE GROUP TOGETHER

Do you feel like you are in a season where time is passing quickly or going slowly? Are you in a season where you are anxious, excited, anticipatory, or bored?

What's your "go-to" method for passing time? Do you use social media, watch tv, read a book, or something else? Do you often find yourself bored and looking for stimulation or do you often find yourself "overstimulated" and looking to alleviate tha?

## TIMING YOURSELF

Share what groups you are a part of. And the level of accountability. Ex: You have a lot of accountability to your family typically, but less so to your book club.

Discuss with the group how each member fits into the group to accomplish something bigger than yourself. If you are a family, it can be how each member serves and cares for the family and development of each person. If you are a small group or discussion group, share how your group makes an impact at your church, and the ways that each member contributes. Then discuss you all can support each other in pursuing your goals and purposes as well as relationally support each other.

# THIS WEEK'S GROUP METHOD BIBLE STUDY

#### **GATHER**

Welcome back, everybody! We're glad you're all here! Let's get started with praying together.

#### READ

Have someone read Psalm 90 out loud.

#### **OBSERVE**

Psalm 90 is mostly a reminder of each individual person's mortality and finite essence. It even includes a prayer to be reminded of our mortality and for God to teach the Psalmist to always have this in mind. But the final verse is a request for God to establish what we accomplish (as a people) so that it endures beyond our lives. How would you wrestle through this with God? Do you track along with the psalmist or is this something you don't feel or think about?

#### UNDERSTAND

If our lives are finite but the work of our hands can be established and endure on far longer, what do you want to accomplish? Individually, as a family, or as a group?

What pieces are missing and preventing you from accomplishing that? How can you help someone in your group establish their works for the glory of the Lord? How can they help you?


### **PRAYER**

Invite God into your group, invite God to speak to you through the passage AND through those in your group, and pray that God would unite your group with him and each other.
